The International College of Management (ICMS) will award three National Scholarships commencing in February 2012. These scholarships are open to Australian citizens completing either year 12 studies or gap year in 2011.

The scholarship covers the full tuition fee for the three years of study regardless as to which stream is chosen. The tuition fees are up to AU\$64,343 (33 subjects including Leadership Conference).

Applications will be evaluated by the Scholarship Board, consisting of members of the administration and academic departments and the office of the registrar of ICMS.

The presentation, content, relevance and creativity of the application and the academic merit of the applicant will be considered. Applications close on 21st October 2011 and no late applications will be accepted.

Initially a group of finalists will be chosen based on stages one and two of this application.

The final three Scholarship winners will be chosen from the group of finalists, based on their interview and final year 12 results.

## APPLICATION PROCESS

### STAGE 1: Report

Please submit a detailed report addressing the following points. (Maximum 500 words)

- 1). How will you personally benefit from an education at ICMS?
- 2). Outline your experience in working in teams and how you intend to apply that experience during your time at ICMS?
- 3). Consider your career goal for the future. You have graduated from ICMS and you are in a management role. Describe your position and explain how your experiences at ICMS have helped you reach this level.

## STAGE 2: Interview

Based on Stage one, the finalists will be selected for a personal interview by the Scholarship Panel. The interview, which will be conducted at the ICMS campus in Manly, NSW, will be used to further ascertain the candidates' suitability to the industry and the College in general.

## STAGE 3: Academic

The final three scholarship recipients will be selected based on final year 12 results.

### TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- The three National Scholarship winners will be announced within 48 hours of receipt of all final results. All semi-finalists will be personally contacted at this time.
- The Scholarship covers the academic component for the three years of study regardless as to which stream is chosen. The cost of accommodation and other incidentals (text books etc) are not included in the Scholarship.
- Interviews are held on campus at 151 Darley Road, Manly, NSW.
- The Scholarship recipients are required to allow the ICMS Marketing Department to take their photo and write a student profile about them for publications and website use. Recipients must also have a willingness to participate in future marketing activities.
- The Scholarship recipient must complete a minimum of 40 hours of Community Contribution hours each term.
- The Scholarship recipient must actively participate in at least one student committee and be a Student Ambassador each term while studying on campus (not necessary during Industry Training).
- The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Bachelor Degree.
- The Scholarship Board's decision is final and reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship at any time for poor academic performance, inappropriate conduct (see ICMS Student Handbook) or failure to contribute in the spirit of being an ICMS Scholarship recipient.
- College fees are subject to change.
- Acceptance of the ICMS National Scholarship is for the ICMS Bachelor Degree (including chosen specialisation) and will rescind your need for a 2012 CSP position.

### CAREER WEEK SCHOLARSHIPS

The unsuccessful finalists will be awarded a career week scholarship for their school to the value of AU\$299. The Careers Advisor of the school may elect a year 11 or 12 student to attend a 2012 career week.

The recipient can select the career week date that best suits their requirements however the offer is subject to availability.
