WHAT IS THE ICMS SCHOLARSHIP?

Each year ICMS offers one Scholarship of a full tuition waiver for units of study in either the ICMS Specialist Bachelor Degree or the ICMS Bachelor of Business Management Degree.

This prestigious scholarship at ICMS is designed to reward dedication, innovation, and aptitude. It is sponsored by Touraust Corporation, the parent company of ICMS, founded some 25 years ago.

Applications for the ICMS Scholarship are invited from students who are graduating from the Associate Degree or have successfully completed the first two years of the ICMS Degree who demonstrate excellence in academia, industry training, professional performance, and overall contribution to ICMS.

CRITERIA TO APPLY:

- Cumulative Grade Point Average (CGPA) of 3.0 or above
- A good Professional Conduct Assessment
- An outstanding Industry Training Assessment Report or excellent previous work references
- Participated in and contributed to the College community
- ICMS Cultural Fit - Student must be able to demonstrate a high level of maturity and commitment to the ICMS organisation.

Along with your application, an ICMS Report (about 3-pages in length) will need to be submitted by the recipient, which addresses their ongoing career goal/aspiration within the International College of Management, Sydney.

You may only apply once for this scholarship. Should any opportunities within ICMS become available either during and/or upon graduation, for which the Scholarship student is suitable, then the student is expected to apply, be available to accept and commence their career with the organisation.

WHAT IS INVOLVED?

Over the duration of study under this Scholarship scheme, the recipient must be willing and available to participate in a work-experience program (commitment hours) within ICMS.

This will consist of:

- At least one eight-hour session or two four-hour sessions per week, commencing in week 2 and up to and including week 11 (minimum of 80 hours per term).
- The completion of a project which will be set at the start of the ICMS Scholarship program by the assigned manager
- A weekly Project Report to be completed by the Scholarship student and the assigned manager
- The recipient will have exposure to various departments within the ICMS organisation.

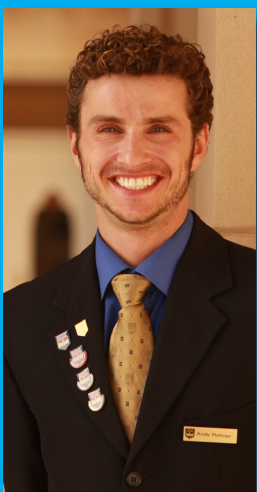
HOW DO I APPLY?

To apply please submit a one-page covering letter addressing the five criteria listed above along with the three-page ICMS Report. Submissions are due by **5.00pm on Friday of Week 9** addressed as below. The ICMS Scholarship panel will assess every application and finalists will be required to attend an ICMS Scholarship panel interview, prior to final selection. The successful applicant will be announced at the End of Term Dinner.
