Entry Requirements for ICMS Graduate Certificate of Business Administration (Pathway to MBA): Relevant professional work experience (or attend an interview with the relevant Program Manager to assess merit based entry criteria if the applicant does not have relevant professional work experience)*

AND

Meet one of the following academic entry requirements:

- Successful completion of a Bachelor degree from an Australian higher education institution overseas equivalent with a minimum grade average, GPA 2.5 (on a 5 point scale). OR
- Successful completion of a Graduate Certificate from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent. OR
- Successful completion of at least two award, or two non-award, postgraduate subjects (at AQF
- Level 8 or above) from an Australian higher education institution or overseas equivalent. *OR*Successful completion of an approved Postgraduate Qualifying Program from an Australian
- higher education institution or overseas equivalent. *OR*For mature age entry (21+): successful completion of a diploma or associate degree qualification (or equivalent as recognised by the Australian Government's qualifications recognition tool) AND five years of relevant management experience.
