### **5 January 2016**

#### **Morning: Arrive in Sydney**

You will be met by an ICMS Representative, collect your luggage, and be transferred by charter coach from the airport to your accommodation.

#### **11.00am: Arrive to ICMS - Introduction - 'Welcome to Australia'**

This exclusive presentation is an introductory session which explores the differences and similarities between American culture and that of Australia. Essential safety advice is covered, as well laws relating to the country to ensure a happy and safe stay. During the presentation, participants will receive a detailed course itinerary. Be welcomed by ICMS, learn about the College, programs, and students, check into your accommodation, and be guided on a campus tour to familiarize yourself with your 'home base' for the week.

#### **2pm: ICMS hosted visit to Manly Beach**

*\*Note: Your educational Brewing lecture will be at 4pm, so you may choose to stay in Manly after lecture for dinner at 6.00pm. Please take anything you may need at dinner (i.e. cash/bank card)*

Enjoy a semi-formal activity by/on the beach and learn where to find a host of services you may need during your Sydney stay, such as the post office, chemist, and grocery store.

Australia is famed for its beaches and Manly is no exception. A visit to this beach will give participants their first glimpse of the 'beach culture' upon which much of Australia is based. This beach is highly popular with tourists and locals alike; a popularity rivaled only by the famous Bondi Beach south of the harbour. Manly Beach has long been a fascination for poets (most notably Bruce Beaver), artists and photographers. The Corso links the harbour to the seaside, which is home to beach volleyball, surf competitions, the international jazz festival, the food and wine festival and loads more. Manly is also packed with bars, cafes, nightclubs, hotels, and excellent restaurants.

Enjoy a casual walk around Manly beach to familiarize yourself with the surroundings and local restaurants.

3. Turn left onto Wentworth St
  4. Turn right onto East Esplanade and you are in the centre of Manly!
