


ICMS PARKING REGULATIONS



All students are required to register their vehicle. Relevant parking permits must be displayed when parking on campus and vehicles must only be parked in authorised areas. Students are responsible for their vehicles, while they are parked on campus.



Map Guide: Student parking areas are marked in blue (Front of the Moran House and right hand side of Formal Driveway). Resident only parking spots commence from the front of classrooms 15 & 16 in the staff car park.

The college reserves the right to have vehicles moved or removed whilst parked on site, at the expense of the vehicle's owner. Any vehicles parked on-campus must be registered with the Roads and Maritime Services. Proof of Registration may be requested. **Under the conditions of entry:** No responsibility will be taken for any damage sustained to your car while parked/driven at ICMS.

ICMS Residents may park in the "ICMS Residents Only" parking area when displaying a black resident parking permit. If residents find that the assigned area is full, they may park in an alternative student parking area; however the car must be returned to the "ICMS Residents Only" parking area by 08:00AM on the following day.



Driving on Campus

Any student that drives/rides in a manner that is considered dangerous to others will have a warning recorded against their name. This would include driving/riding at a speed that a staff member considers to be in excess of the 15 km/h limit, or any other reckless behaviour. ICMS may prohibit students from parking on campus for a period to be determined by the House Manager.

Parking is prohibited in the following areas: Chapel side of the Formal Driveway, all grass areas, Visitor Car Park, 15 min loading zone, pathways, entranceways, no parking areas, ICMS Head Office parking area, adjacent to the Piazza, NO PARKING zone next to the waste & recycling area, NO PARKING zone next to Chapel, Executive parking areas, Cerretti Crescent residential areas & disabled parking bays (without a disabled parking permit), non-residents parking in residential parking area, Staff parking areas.

Please note that parking anywhere on the St. Patrick's Estate, other than on our campus, is strictly forbidden.

Parking Warning Procedure

- First Offence - 1st Warning
- Second Offence - Final Warning
- Third Offence - Privilege to park on-campus retracted for 30 days during Term

If students are found to be parked or have driven on-campus after their parking privilege has been retracted; further disciplinary action will be taken. ICMS may clamp vehicles.

Students are expected to be cooperative at all times and therefore are expected to follow instructions given to them by any Operations and Security team member.

Please be aware that ICMS can only offer a limited number of parking spaces. There are likely to be times when all parking areas are full.
