Sydney, the oldest, biggest, and most beautiful of all Australian cities, lies amid a seductive intermingling of land and sea. Glide along the glittering harbour on a ferry, see the white sails of the Opera House gleaming in the sunshine, admire the graceful arch of the Harbour Bridge, and it's hard to imagine this vibrant state capital of New South Wales was once a convict colony. In 1788, it was at Sydney Cove where Captain Arthur Phillip, commander of the First Fleet, established the first British colony in Australia.

Today, you can explore Sydney's fabled history in the narrow, cobbled laneways and historic buildings of the Rocks and the city's excellent museums, where you can also learn about the Aboriginal people, who once thrived on this land. Sydney still fizzles with the adventurous spirit of its settlers. You can climb the harbour bridge, encounter an echidna on a bushwalk, surf the green-barrel breaks at Sydney's golden beaches or explore hidden coves and secret sunbathing spots around the dazzling harbour.

SYDNEY IN SUMMERTIME

January is summertime in Sydney and is the ideal time to experience the best of the ultimate easy-going Aussie lifestyle. The average temperatures range from 18.6 - 25.8°C (65.5 - 78.4°F). This is, of course, a great time to enjoy Sydney's abundant beaches, when water temperatures rise to a comfortable 21.9 - 23.7°C (71.4 - 74.7°F).

YOUR MANLY PLAYGROUND

The ICMS campus overlooks the relaxed sea-side suburb of Manly and has a distinctive holiday vibe. On the Corso and adjacent to the beach is a delicious range of restaurants which range from world-class cuisine to lively pubs, clubs and dance venues. Or buy takeaway fish 'n' chips and savour them on the soft sand while soaking up the laid-back beach lifestyle and watching surfers gracefully manoeuvre the waves. Getting to the city from Manly is easy. Hop on the famous Manly ferry and glide across one of the world's great natural harbours.

VOTED BEST BEACH

Right on the ICMS campus doorstep is Manly Beach - voted the best beach in Australia two years running by travel website TripAdvisor. You'll find plenty of wonderful things to do and see on Manly Beach, from picnics on the promenade to fun excursions such as surfing, snorkeling, diving, cycling and walking. The iconic beach curves from South Steyne to Queenscliff, where a submerged reef, or bombora, creates waves prized by the world's top surfers.

Just below the ICMS campus you'll find Shelly Beach in Cabbage Tree Bay, an aquatic reserve teeming with colourful fish such as blue groper and cuttlefish. Shelly Beach is perfect for sunset visitor barbecues and picnics. A walk around the promenade from Shelly Beach to Manly hugs the headland and offers spectacular views of the coastline and ocean.

The interconnectedness of so many elements of iconic Australian culture, nature and wildlife makes the Sydney location a truly special place.

A LANDMARK CAMPUS

The ICMS campus is the jewel in Sydney's crown. Towering turrets and lofty spires are the hallmarks of the iconic sandstone campus building, known to locals as "the castle on the hill".

The campus buildings form part of the UNESCO awarded St Patrick's Estate, with the main building dating back to the 19th century when it was built between 1885 and 1889 as the first National Catholic Seminary in Australia.

Since 1996 the campus has been home to ICMS, maintaining the tradition of education excellence within a global context and offering a classroom experience that would be hard to beat anywhere in the world.

The romantic beauty of the ICMS campus buildings means it is in high demand for weddings, including the high-profile wedding of celebrities Nicole Kidman and Keith Urban.

The imposing classical sandstone building also doubled as Gatsby's mansion in the Baz Luhrmann's 2013 filming of The Great Gatsby, starring Leonardo DiCaprio.

ON-CAMPUS ACCOMMODATION

Staying on-campus at ICMS is the ideal way to fully immerse yourself in Australian summer lifestyle in one of the world's most desirable destinations. Accommodation is available in single or share rooms.
