SURF LIFE SAVING SYDNEY NORTHERN BEACHES SCHOLARSHIP - September 2021



The International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS) has partnered with Surf Life Saving Sydney Northern Beaches (SLSSNB) to award an ICMS Sports Management, Event Management or Business Management students a unique scholarship offering a tuition waiver valued at UP TO \$10,000, and an internship with SLSSNB with an amount of \$300 paid each week to the successful candidate during the internship. The SLSSNB Scholarship is awarded to a student who displays enthusiasm and motivation for the sporting and/or events industry and whose aptitude, academic results and previous work experience fit with the sponsor's (SLSSNB) business goals.

Applications for the SLSSNB Scholarship are invited from students who have currently completed term 2 or 3 of their degree and successful completion of IND200. The student must be enrolled in the ICMS Bachelor of Sports Management, Bachelor of Event Management or Bachelor of Business Management. Applicants must have demonstrated consistency in academia, professional performance, and overall contribution to ICMS. Work experience in an area of relevance is preferred.

The SLSSNB Scholarship is awarded to the student based on the selection process implemented by the ICMS Scholarship board.

Value: A tuition waiver valued at **UP TO \$10,000** at current tuition fee levels (applies to domestic or international students) plus an internship at SLSSNB with an amount of \$300 paid each week to the successful candidate during the internship. The successful student is required to work full time at SLSSNB at their Warriewood location during the internship, and this can be counted as part of industry training placement hours.

SLSSNB coordinates the delivery of volunteer lifesaving services throughout the summer months with its 21 Surf Life Saving Clubs between Manly and North Palm Beach. With just under 20,000 volunteer members, SLSSNB plays an integral part in managing beach safety, providing community education, building great Australians and saving lives. Benefits of the SLSSNB Scholarship

Tuition: Investment in your future education, development and career.

Build Your CV Now: A placement with Surf Life Saving Sydney Northern Beaches will reward you with real experiences in development, planning, logistics and on-site delivery of surf sports and other events.

Positioning: This presents a unique opportunity for you to gain business knowledge and expertise that can take years to master. This may present the chance to place yourself in a stand out position in an organisation or career path.

Recognition: In addition to a great head start on your CV, recognition for scholarship holders will be demonstrated at the Dean's List presentation and at graduation. Official recognition will further help raise your profile as a sponsored scholar graduating from ICMS.

Building Networks: Through the range of activities and commitments involved by being a sponsored scholar at ICMS. As outlined, you will have the potential to build your networks and open new doors and widen your horizons.

Selection Process

1. Completed Application Form

2. Finalists will be selected based on the following criteria:

a) Academic Record and Degree Progress

You need to meet the ICMS entry requirements in academic ability and maintain a minimum GPA of 2.7 and have completed term 2 or 3 of their degree and successful completion of IND200.

b) Essay Submission (Minimum 500 words)

Address the following questions within a 500 word (minimum) essay:

- Why are you the most suitable student to be awarded this scholarship?
- What could you bring to the Surf Life Saving Sydney Northern Beaches?
- Where do you hope to be five years from graduating? How will your ICMS education and work experience within SLSSNB contribute to this?

c) Industry Training Report and CV

If you have completed any or all of your industry training placement, please submit a copy of your industry training report outlining performance. Please include a copy of your most up to date CV.

d) Community, Leadership and Student Body Contributions

Community contributions form a vital part of your application. Include relevant information, for example, student representative council, community volunteering, and others.

3. Interview Stage

Students who are successful with their essay submission will progress to the interview stage. The interview will be conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board including a representative from the SLSSNB.

Students who reach this stage will be contacted and notified of interview dates and times.

4. Announcement

Only finalists will be notified of the results by letter and email.

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will **not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Acceptance Procedure

Upon notification of being awarded the SLSSNB Scholarship, the successful candidate is required to inform the College of acceptance or non-acceptance, in writing, within two working days of receipt of notification.

Terms & Conditions

1. The recipient of the SLSSNB Scholarship agrees to abide by all prescribed rules and regulations of ICMS.
2. The recipient must have completed in full a minimum of two academic study periods and is required to maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.7 prior to and during the tenure of the scholarship.
3. The SLSSNB Scholarship is not refundable and non-transferable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
4. The SLSSNB Scholarship or carried over credits are unable to be extended and should the recipient decide to cease the scholarship prior to completion then the total cost of all subjects undertaken (as at the cease date) must be refunded in full.
5. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
6. The SLSSNB Scholarship may not be deferred.
7. Scholarship students are expected to maintain good to excellent overall professional conduct and act as ambassadors of the College at all times. Failure to do so may result in withdrawal or termination of the scholarship.
8. SLSSNB reserves the right to terminate the scholarship should the scholarship student not meet a desired level of performance and/or professional conduct during internship hours.
9. Termination of the scholarship by either ICMS or SLSSNB will result in cessation of any allowance and tuition fee waiver awarded to the recipient.
10. If the recipient of the SLSSNB Scholarship is required to re-sit a degree subject, for whatever reason, he/she will be required to pay for that subject.
11. The recipient will be required to complete the necessary academic requirements while on placement as outlined the Work Integrated Learning Guidelines
12. The Scholarship recipient is required to allow the ICMS Marketing Department to take his/her photo and write a student profile about him/her for publications and website use. The recipient must also have a willingness to participate in future marketing activities.
13. The scholarship recipient is required to be available to participate in representing ICMS at various events for example Career Expo's, Open Days, Orientation Weeks, etc.
14. The scholarship recipient will be required to complete an internship at SLSSNB. This internship may involve a variety of activities including (but not limited to) event development and planning, dealing with contractors, volunteers, and suppliers, risk and safety management, liaising with security companies and dealing with statutory agencies. The student will receive a weekly amount set by this scholarship.
15. The Scholarship recipient must actively participate in at least one student committee and/or be a student ambassador in the study period following their internship with SLSSNB.
16. The Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Bachelor degree.
17. College fees are subject to change.
18. ICMS or SLSSNB decision is final and reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship at any time for poor academic performance (see above), professional conduct, inappropriate conduct (see ICMS Student Handbook) or failure to meet the requirements of SLSSNB. In some cases, ICMS may deem that payment of tuition must be reimbursed by the student.
