The ICMS Master of Event Management is designed for working professionals seeking a recognised formal qualification in the dynamic, international Event Management sector, as well as postgraduate students seeking exposure to industry best practice.

WORK EXPERIENCE AS ACADEMIC CREDIT

ICMS offers all students the opportunity to undertake an industry training component embedded within their course, with Masters' students having the ability to complete 600 hours or the option to use their current working position for their industry training hours through the Recognition of Prior Learning program*.

*Those with relevant work experience may be able to complete their Masters in under 1 year by gaining Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL). RPL is an assessment process that involves assessment of an individual's relevant prior learning (including formal, informal and non-formal learning) to determine the credit outcomes of an individual application for credit.

*Normal full-time duration is 2 years.
