The International College of Management (ICMS) has developed a scholarship program to reward the most promising scholars based on their effort, dedication, attitude and aptitude, demonstrated business acumen and motivation. Touraust Corporation, the original founding organisation of ICMS, is also the original founding sponsor of the ICMS Professional Scholarship once known as the Touraust Scholarship.

Applications for this ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship are invited from students with full time or equivalent study load with a maximum of six (6) subjects (excluding WIL) remaining not including this study period of their Master degree at ICMS. Students must have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.20 out of 5.0 to be eligible. Students applying will have demonstrated consistency in academia, and excellence in innovation, professional performance, and overall contribution to ICMS.

The ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship will be awarded upon the selection process implemented by the ICMS Scholarship Board.

Value:	Tuition Waiver UP TO four (4) postgraduate subjects*
Applications Due:	by 5pm on Friday 28 April 2023, for students with a maximum of six (6) subjects (excluding WIL) remaining not including this study period of an ICMS Master degree program.

*PLEASE NOTE – Partial Scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high.

A key priority of the ICMS Scholarship Program is to create opportunities for as many students as possible, where eligible. In support of this priority, previous recipients of this scholarship are not eligible to apply.

All scholarships awarded are subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.

Benefits of the ICMS Professional Scholarship Program

Tuition:	Invest in your future education, development and career.
Build Your CV:	Your scholarship certificate will be an asset to your CV.
Positioning:	This presents a unique opportunity to potentially gain expertise that can take years to nurture and master. This can present the chance to place yourself in a stand out position in an organisation or career path.
Recognition:	In addition to a great head start on your CV, you will be recognised as a scholarship holder at the Dean's List presentation. Official recognition will further help raise your profile as a sponsored scholar graduating from an ICMS Master degree.
Build Networks:	Build your networks by being involved in a range of ICMS activities and commitments as a sponsored scholar at ICMS. You will be able to potentially opening new doors and broadening your horizons.



Selection Process:

1. Complete Application Form

Email your submission to <u>icmsscholarships@icms.edu.au</u> (with "PG Current Student" in the email's subject line) with community, leadership & student body contributions report & essay attached.

2. Finalists will be selected based on the following criteria:

a) Academic Record

Applicants need to meet the ICMS entry requirements in academic ability and have a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.20 out of 5.0.

b) Essay Submission (Minimum 500 words and Maximum 1000 words)

Applicants should address the following questions within their essay:

- Your reasons for choosing ICMS, including the reasons you chose the program/specialisation.
- Why are you the most appropriate student to be awarded this scholarship?
- Do you have innovative ideas in business that could assist in a Department at ICMS? Please provide details of how your ideas could be used in a department at ICMS or for the overall business.
- What type of position do you see yourself in upon completion of your ICMS Master degree?

c) Community, Leadership and Student Body Contributions

The applicant's community contributions form a vital part of their background and application for the ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship. Include all relevant information past and present. For example, details of place-holdings such as Student Representative Council, community volunteering, and other areas you have assisted in the Manly/ICMS community. Please mention this in your community, leadership & student body contributions report.

3. Interview Stage

Students who are successful with their essay and ICMS entry requirements will progress to the interview stage. Panel interviews are conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board and will be held in Week 12-13. Please ensure you are available during this time. Dates are subject to change.

4. Announcement

All applicants will be notified of the results by letter and/or email.

NOTE: Hard copy Scholarship submissions will **not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Acceptance Procedure

Upon notification of being awarded the ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship, the successful candidate is required to inform the College of acceptance or non-acceptance, in writing, within two (2) working days of receipt of notification.



Terms & Conditions (please read carefully before signing the declaration)

- 1. The recipient must be enrolled in an ICMS Master program, with a maximum of six (6) subjects (excluding WIL) remaining not including this study period and a minimum GPA of 3.20 out of 5.0.
- 2. Scholarship recipients are required to maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 3.20 out of 5.0 during the tenure of their scholarship.
- 3. Applicants must have a full time or equivalent study load to be eligible to apply.
- 4. Past recipients of the Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
- 5. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
- 6. Previous scholarship recipients cannot have existing scholarship credit remaining as at the commencement of the study period they are applying for.
- 7. The Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ICMS.
- 8. The ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship are not refundable and non-transferable, unable to be extended and should the recipient decide to cease the scholarship prior to completion then the total cost of all subjects undertaken (as at the cease date) must be refunded in full.
- 9. The ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship offers a tuition waiver **UP TO** the value of four (4) postgraduate subjects. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. Subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- 10. An ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship may not be deferred.
- 11. The recipient of the ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship agrees to abide by all prescribed rules and regulations of ICMS. Scholarship students are expected to maintain good to excellent overall professional conduct and act as ambassadors of the College at all times.
- 12. If the recipient of the ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship is required to re-sit a subject, for whatever reason, he/she will be required to pay for that subject.
- 13. The recipient of the ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship will be required to take on the role of Class Representative in the event that your group has not elected a Class Representative. Every effort will be made to appoint a suitable candidate for the Class Representative position and we suggest you nominate yourself.
- 14. Activities of the scholarship holder may include:
 - Representing the College at events and expos, VIP functions and visits
 - Assisting at College events such as Graduation Day and Open Day
 - Assisting the Pollard Resource Centre and Academic Support Centre
 - Assisting with student events and functions
 - Submissions to College publications
 - Student Services activities
 - Participation in community/charity work
- 15. Scholarship recipients are required to allow the ICMS Marketing Department to take their photo and write a student profile about them for publications and website use. Recipients must also be willing to participate in future marketing activities, and act as an ambassador for ICMS locally and if applicable in their home country.
- 16. It is suggested that the Scholarship recipient contribute up to 10 contribution hours* per week for the study period that the scholarship applies.
- 17. College fees are subject to change.
- 18. The Scholarship Board's decision is final and reserves the right to terminate the Scholarship at any time for poor academic performance (see above), professional conduct, or inappropriate conduct (see ICMS Student Handbook) College or Community Contribution hours or failure to meet the requirements of the ICMS Postgraduate Innovation Scholarship.

*Contribution Hours can be discussed with the Scholarship Chairperson.
