## **ACADEMIC EXCELLENCE SCHOLARSHIP**May 2024



Academic Excellence Scholarships are awarded based solely on academic results. Applicants must have a full time or equivalent study load, and have between <u>4 and 12 subjects remaining (including WIL)</u> not including the current study period. The actual scholarship selection made by the Academic Scholarship panel is not confirmed until your current study periods results can be assessed. However, do not let this deter you from applying; you do not have to wait. As long as you have a cumulative GPA score of 4.5 or higher (based on your most recent scores), you are eligible to apply.

Value: Highest academic performance as measured by cGPA (or weighted average mark where two or more

applicants have the same cGPA) - Full fee waiver up to 4 subjects

Second highest academic performance as measured by cGPA (or weighted average mark where two or

more applicants have the same cGPA) – Full fee waiver up to 2 subjects

Applications Due: 5pm Friday 19 April 2024\* - Week 11 (for the May 2024 study period)

A key priority of the ICMS Scholarship Program is to create opportunities for as many students as possible, where eligible. In support of this priority, previous recipients of this scholarship are not eligible to apply.

- Students must achieve a cumulative GPA equal to or greater than 4.5 to be eligible for an Academic Excellence scholarship.
- Once all applications have been received, ICMS will confirm each applicant's cumulative GPA and award scholarships to students who have the highest cumulative GPA scores.
- The decision to award an Academic Scholarship may be impacted by the level of academic performance of all students
- Where two or more students have the same cumulative GPA, the scholarship will be awarded to the student having the highest weighted average mark (WAM) over their first five study periods of study.
- All applicants will be notified of the results by letter and email.

**NOTE**: Scholarship submissions will not be returned. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

### Terms & Conditions (please read carefully before signing the declaration)

- 1. The recipient must be enrolled in an ICMS degree, with between 4 and 12 subjects (including WIL) remaining not including the current study period of their degree.
- 2. Applicants must have a full time or equivalent study load to be eligible to apply.
- 3. ICMS Scholarships are not refundable and non-transferrable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
- 4. Past recipients of the Academic Excellence Scholarship are not eligible to apply.
- 5. Students with Articulation Agreements must be studying a minimum of 2 years of their degree at ICMS (includes WIL).
- 6. Previous scholarship recipients cannot have existing scholarship credit remaining as at the commencement of the study period they are applying for.
- 7. Scholarship Applicants may only apply for one Scholarship per study period Multiple scholarship applications will not be accepted. Exception: Academic Excellence Scholarship applicants may also apply for the Courtney-O'Connor Scholarship if eligible with the understanding the Academic Excellence Scholarship will take precedence if successful.
- 8. Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 4.5 or higher to be considered for the award of an Academic Excellence scholarship.
- 9. Applicants must submit a completed application form by the due date to be considered.
- 10. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
- 11. An Academic Excellence Scholarship may not be deferred.
- 12. Scholarships are awarded independently of the specialisation undertaken.
- 13. Scholarship recipients are required to maintain a minimum cumulative GPA of 4.0 during the tenure of their scholarship. Failure to maintain this minimum GPA will result in termination of the scholarship.
- 14. Scholarship recipients are required to allow the ICMS Marketing department to take their photo and write a student profile about them for publications and website use. Recipients must also have a willingness to participate in future marketing activities.
- 15. Where possible Scholarship recipients should consider doing some contribution hours\* each study period that the scholarship applies.
- 16. It is recommended that Scholarship recipients participate in at least one student committee.
- 17. Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Bachelor degree.
- 18. The Scholarship Board's decision is final and reserves the right to terminate the scholarship at any time for poor academic performance (see above), professional conduct, or inappropriate conduct (see ICMS Student Handbook).
- 19. Academic Integrity: Academic misconduct will be reviewed from time to time. Any academic misconduct can inhibit your scholarship. Should your academic misconduct be registered as level 2 or 3 during your applicable scholarship, the scholarship credit will be immediately discontinued.
