

DISCOVER THE BEAUTY OF AUSTRALIA



LIVING IN SYDNEY

Sydney is the state capital of New South Wales. This spectacular city of more than five million people is widely regarded as one of the world's most liveable cities. An extremely pleasant climate helps; even in midwinter, temperatures rarely fall below 50°F (10°C), and while mid summer temperatures can occasionally top 97°F (36°C), the average is around 82°F (28°C). Remember though, that southern hemisphere seasons are opposite to the northern hemisphere.

WHAT A LOCATION

The magnificent heritage-listed castle
has more than 100 years of history
behind it. It overlooks Sydney's famous
Manly Beach and boasts 20 hectares
of parkland. This safe and peaceful

harbour, where you can travel by fast
ferry to Sydney's Circular Quay in just
17 minutes.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

All Study Abroad students need an Australian Student Visa to enter Australia. For more information about visa requirements and processing, go to *studyaustralia.gov.au*. Please note that visa processing times may vary.

A LIFE EXPERIENCE

Naturally, you will want to do and see as much as you can while you're in Australia.

Here are a few activities you might like to consider:

- Walks to one of nine nearby beaches, such as Manly, Shelly or Collins beach.
- Surfing.
- Beach volleyball.
- Scuba diving.
- Day trips to the Blue Mountains and Hunter Valley wine region.
- Sailing on Sydney Harbour.
- Sports afternoons on campus.
- Sydney city sightseeing tours, such as the Opera House.
- Harbour Bridge climb.
- Seeing the Australian animals at Taronga Zoo.

HEALTH INSURANCE

International students are required to have health insurance during their stay in Australia. ICMS will help you arrange your Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). Depending on the level of cover, OSHC can contribute to doctors' fees, specialists, ambulance, prescription medicines and emergency treatment. Some exemptions to the requirement to purchase OSHC may apply if you are a student from Sweden, Norway, or Belgium.

WORKING IN AUSTRALIA

Study Abroad students may work in Australia while they are studying, as per visa conditions. A part-time or casual job could help to finance living expenses and travel. In Manly and Sydney, there are many job opportunities for students. Check the Australian Government's Department of Home Affairs website for details about working while on a Student Visa.

ACCOMMODATION

As a Study Abroad student, you can choose between on-campus or off-campus accommodation. On-campus accommodation includes all meals. For more details, go to *icms.edu.au/accommodation*. Off-campus accommodation includes shared houses or apartments, or private board.

Study Abroad students can choose to gain work experience in Australia as part of their program.
