ICMS INTERNATIONAL SCHOLARSHIP

The International College of Management (ICMS) developed a scholarship program over 11 years ago to reward the most promising scholars based on their effort, dedication, attitude and aptitude, demonstrated business acumen and motivation.

The International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS) is offering scholarships to new International students who will be commencing their full time or equivalent undergraduate studies at ICMS in May 2026, either on-campus or on-line.

Applicants will be considered for the ICMS International Scholarship*. ICMS will match the candidates to the most appropriate scholarship. Students are welcome to note or refer to a particular scholarship if they wish, however the decision for finalists for each scholarship type remains with the Scholarship board. Partial Scholarships and/or Accommodation Scholarships may be awarded.

The ICMS International Scholarship will be awarded based on the selection process implemented by the ICMS Professional Scholarship board.

Applications Due: 5pm on Friday 3 April 2026 (for the May 2026 study period)

ICMS International Scholarship



Value: **UP TO \$20,000***. ICMS International Scholarships** are awarded to successful applicants each study period. All scholarships cover partial tuition fees for study and/or accommodation at the discretion of the Scholarship Board's selection. The value of all ICMS Professional Scholarships awarded will be advised to the scholarship winner at the time of being notified of their selection.

****Please note – Partial Scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. All scholarships awarded are subject to approval by the Scholarship Board. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.***

***** New international students applying for international scholarships will have a range of factors considered when applying and throughout the interview process including challenging or adverse circumstances.***

Study abroad note:

The ICMS Scholarships Program provides opportunities to students who are completing their bachelor's or master's degree with ICMS as their home institution.

As such, Study Abroad students are not eligible to apply.

Selection Process:

1. Complete Application Form

Submit via email at icmsscholarships@icms.edu.au

2. Finalists will be selected based on the following criteria:

a) Academic & English Requirement

Applicants need to meet the regular ICMS entry requirements in English language proficiency and academic ability.

b) Essay Submission (Minimum 500 words)

Address the following questions within an essay:

- The reasons for choosing ICMS, including the choice of program/specialization
- What will you bring to ICMS?
- Where do you hope to be in 10 years' time and how ICMS will contribute to this?
- Why are you the most appropriate student to be awarded this scholarship?

3. Interview Stage

Students who are successful with their essay and ICMS entry requirements will progress to the interview stage. The student will be interviewed by members of the International Scholarships Board and will be asked a broad range of questions relating to their knowledge of the College and course of their choice, their life and background in general

4. Announcement

All applicants will be notified of the results by letter / email.

NOTE: Scholarship submissions will **not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.

Acceptance Procedure

Upon notification of being awarded a Scholarship, the successful candidate is required to inform the college of acceptance or non-acceptance, in writing within 2 working days of receipt of notification.

A letter of acceptance will be issued outlining the details of enrolment at ICMS within 2 working days.

Enrolment fees must be paid upon acceptance of the student's letter of offer and it is not refundable.

Terms & Conditions (please read carefully before signing the declaration)

1. All applicants must hold an international passport. This excludes dual citizens of Australia and elsewhere, permanent residents and temporary residents. New Zealand applicants are classified as Domestic and therefore are not eligible to apply.
 2. ICMS International Scholarships are not refundable and non-transferrable. The scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
 3. The Scholarship Recipient agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and all requirements in the student handbook whilst enrolled. (<https://handbook.icms.edu.au/>)
 1. The scholarship must be redeemed by students commencing their studies in May 2026 study period only.
 2. If the Scholarship Recipient fails a subject, he/she is obliged to retake the subject at their cost at the full subject price.
 3. The applicant is required to submit their Scholarship Application by 5pm Friday 3 April 2026 (Australian Eastern Standard Time).
Applications must include:
 - English language proficiency,
 - Academic proficiency,
 - Essay,
 - Scholarship application form,
 - Photo – Headshot (School photograph is acceptable),
 - Copy of passport,
 - Full Letter of Offer from ICMS Admissions,
 4. Applicants must have a full time or equivalent study load to be eligible to apply.
 5. Scholarship Applicants may only apply for one Scholarship per study period – Multiple scholarship applications will not be accepted.
 6. All final applicants will be contacted by ICMS within 5 working days after application closing date. Final applicants will be selected based on their essay.
 7. The scholarship is a tuition (and/or accommodation) waiver that can only be used for the purpose of attending ICMS for the program as specified. The balance of remaining fees, including tuition, accommodation, uniforms, text books and any other program related costs for each enrolling study period must be paid in full prior to study period commencement.
 8. The scholarship is to the total value of **UP TO AU\$20,000**. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high. Subject to approval by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- Accommodation/Living Costs Credit description:**
- Rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, heating and wireless internet. All linen is provided and rooms are dusted and vacuumed once a week. Each floor is equipped with a kitchenette, common showers, toilets and ironing facilities. You will also receive residential support from the residential assistants. Your accommodation/Living Costs credit includes the following:
- Rent
 - 3 x Meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) – Monday to Friday
 - 2 x Meals per day (Brunch and Dinner) - Weekends
 - Electricity, Gas and Water
 - On site parking
 - Campus wide Wi-Fi
9. In certain cases, the scholarship amount awarded will be credited to tuition as a portion of the fees in each study period for the duration of the course of their study or until the scholarship credit is exhausted. In some cases, scholarship credit can and may be applied to a later study period than the commencement study period.
 10. In the case of the scholarship recipient discontinuing studies any and all remaining credit will be forfeited.
 11. The value of the scholarship and the timing of the credit apportionment are not negotiable and not changeable.
 12. Previous scholarship recipients cannot have existing scholarship credit remaining as at the commencement of the study period they are applying for*.

13. If the recipient's scholarship involves a work placement and a tuition credit component, the tuition credit will apply to the next term of study.
14. At no time will any scholarship credit apply to fees already paid.
15. The ICMS International Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ICMS**.
16. The deposit fee is to be paid as stipulated in the letter of offer, sent by ICMS.
17. Any persons deemed to have misrepresented themselves in their application through fraudulent documents or identity in the interview will forfeit the scholarship and lose their deposit.
18. Where possible Scholarship recipients should consider doing some contribution hours*** each study period that the scholarship applies.
19. Students will also provide the marketing department with a photo, profile and have a willingness to participate in future marketing, blogging and College activities and act as an ambassador for their country.
20. ICMS scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly review of academic integrity, standing and student conduct.
21. Retakes or re-sits of a subject or subjects due to failing the subject are to be paid for by the student and are not included in the Scholarship.
22. Scholarships are awarded for the May 2026 intake only in accordance with the enrolment procedure of the International College of Management, Sydney.
23. The College reserves the right to change or cancel all or part of the Scholarship program without notice. The Scholarship Board's decision is final and reserves the right to terminate the scholarship at any time for poor academic performance (see above), professional conduct, or inappropriate conduct (see ICMS Student Handbook)
24. Academic Integrity will be reviewed from time to time. Any academic misconduct can inhibit your scholarship. Academic misconduct registered as level 2 or 3 during the applicable scholarship, will result in immediate discontinuation of the scholarship.
25. Scholarship value is subject to change in line with program and fee changes.
26. Accommodation and tuition fees are in Australian Dollars and are subject to change.
27. Applicants must have a full letter of offer from ICMS Admissions to be eligible to apply for this Scholarship.
28. The ICMS International Scholarship may not be deferred.
29. College fees are subject to change.

**Exemptions may apply depending on the scholarship type.*

***Excludes the ICMS Regional and Interstate Student Accommodation Bursary.*

**** Contribution Hours can be discussed with the Scholarship Chairperson.*
