The Ceremonial Mace

In 2022, the International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS), Aspire Institute and International Sport College Australia (ISCA) introduced the ceremonial mace to formal proceedings for the first time, marking a significant stage in the college's maturity as a higher education institution.


It is believed that the current traditions are founded in medieval England where the mace was employed in the protection of dignitaries at formal events and ceremonies. Since that time maces have become common in formal proceedings of governments and also within the higher education sector globally.

Now an essential part of official ceremonies in education institutions around the world, it signifies the strength and authority of the institution in higher education and its ability to confer awards on its graduates.

The mace is a physical representation of who we are. It has a spiritual or *Whakapapa* connotation.

Further, as an Australian institution, we are cognisant of the historical significance of the mace in the local environment and also overseas and has developed its own protocols to both honour those traditions but also reflect the college's unique character and history at the same time.

The design of the mace captures the culture and history of both the college and its founding family. It is designed in such a way that its ongoing historical milestones can be captured progressively into the future.

On the ICMS Mace you will see bands of events representing significant events at ICMS.

The Australian walnut timber column on which all of this is carried is encircled by carved statements that depict our stories over the past 29 years. It links our past and present, while also allowing for space for more stories to be added in the future – our Whakapapa.
