LIVING IN SYDNEY

Sydney is the state capital of New South Wales. This spectacular city of more than five-million people is widely regarded as one of the world's most liveable cities. An extremely pleasant climate helps; even in mid-winter, temperatures rarely fall below 50°F (10°C), and while mid-summer temperatures can occasionally top 97°F (36°C), the average is around 82°F (28°C). Remember though, that southern hemisphere seasons are opposite to the northern hemisphere.

WHAT A LOCATION

The ICMS Northern Beaches Campus will take your breath away. With more than 100 years of history behind it, the magnificent heritage-listed 'castle on the hill' overlooks Sydney's famous Manly Beach. It also boasts 20 hectares of surrounding parkland. ICMS is a safe and peaceful environment for study. It's a short walk to Manly wharf, where you can travel by ferry to Sydney's Circular Quay.

VISA REQUIREMENTS

All Study Abroad students need an Australian student visa to enter Australia. Please note that visa processing times may vary. For more information about visa requirements and processing, go to studyaustralia.gov.au

HEALTH INSURANCE

International students on a student visa are required to have health insurance for the duration of their stay in Australia. ICMS can help you arrange your Overseas Student Health Cover (OSHC). Depending on the level of cover, OSHC can contribute to doctors' fees, specialists, ambulance, prescription medicines and emergency treatment. If you are a student from Sweden, Norway, or Belgium, some exemptions to the requirement to purchase OSHC may apply.

WORKING IN AUSTRALIA

Study Abroad students may work in Australia while they are studying, as per visa conditions. A part-time or casual job could help to finance living expenses and travel. In Manly and Sydney, there are many job opportunities for students. Check the Australian Government's Department of Home Affairs website for details about working while on a student visa.

ACCOMMODATION

As a Study Abroad student, you can choose between on-campus or off-campus accommodation. On-campus accommodation includes all meals. For more details, go to icms.edu.au/accommodation. Off-campus accommodation includes shared houses or apartments, or private board.

Students sourcing their own placements must ensure the role meets ICMS academic criteria and any requirements set by their home institution. Home universities may impose additional conditions (eg. timing, documentation, visa conditions), which are the student's responsibility to manage. If a placement ends or does not proceed, students are required to secure an alternative placement to meet course requirements. Failure to complete required hours and assessments may result in a fail grade.
