ICMS Equity Scholarship – Undergraduate

At ICMS there is an integrated college community of international and Australian students, embracing all cultures and the benefits of such diversity. It is a key value of ICMS to enable students from all backgrounds to have an opportunity to study at tertiary level. ICMS can provide equity scholarships for both tuition and/or accommodation, to help financially disadvantaged Australian students in situations of hardship.

Equity Scholarships provide tuition fee waivers to a level decided by the ICMS Scholarship Board. The ICMS Scholarship Board is also able to consider Accommodation/Living Costs scholarships for the eligible applicants. If you are a rural student, please make sure you apply in good time before the closing date to have the best chance of securing accommodation at ICMS.

The ICMS Scholarship Board will manage the selection and allocation of funds.

Value: UP TO \$30,000*

Applications Due: 5pm Friday 20 November 2026 (for the February 2027 study period)

How to Apply:

1. Ensure you meet the eligibility criteria found below
2. Complete your application and prepare your report supporting your application and other documentation if required
3. Apply online at www.icms.edu.au/scholarships by 5pm Friday 20 November 2026**.

** Value of the Scholarship is indicative only and varies according to the course undertaken and may vary from the estimated UP TO value printed here, and from year to year.*

Eligibility:

The eligibility requirements for the ICMS Equity Scholarships are as follows:

1. Australian citizens or permanent residents.
2. Must be a full-time student and have successfully completed Year 12 or equivalent.
3. Can demonstrate financial hardship – A person is considered to be experiencing financial hardship when they are:
 - a) Receiving a Centrelink (or other Commonwealth) means tested income support payment
or
 - b) Expected to receive a Centrelink (or other Commonwealth) means-tested income support payment during 2027
And/or
 - c) Able to provide comprehensive information demonstrating exceptional hardship

Evidence of financial hardship – Equity Scholarship applicants can claim financial hardship under only one of the above categories of financial hardship. Applicants claiming financial hardship must provide one of the following types of evidence. The type of evidence you must provide relates directly to the category of financial hardship you're claiming:

- a) Provision of your Centrelink Customer Reference Number (CRN) when completing the online application
or
 - b) No documentation is required to support eligibility if you expect to receive a means-tested payment. However, when you submit an equity scholarship application, you will be required to verify your receipt of an allowance to ICMS before the Scholarship is taken up
or
 - c) Documentation provided to support eligibility for exceptional financial hardship must demonstrate a level of real enduring financial hardship.
4. Applicants under any of the above categories must prepare a one-page report in support of their application (refer to Report for details).

Report:

Please submit a one page report addressing the following points:

- Why do you believe you should be awarded an Equity Scholarship?
- Why ICMS?
- Why is your chosen course the best choice for you?
- Any other information you wish to include to support your application.

Selection Process:

- The application form (and any supplementary information) is designed to gather sufficient information from applicants to determine which applicants best meet the eligibility criteria and can progress to the panel interview.
- Students who meet the eligibility criteria will progress to the interview stage. The interview is conducted by the ICMS Scholarship Board.
- ICMS Scholarship Board will award the ICMS Equity Scholarships after considering the information contained in the applications submitted and the completed panel interview.
- The decision of the ICMS Scholarship Board is final.

Offer Material:

If your application for an Equity Scholarship is successful, you'll receive a scholarship offer with your letter of offer for a place in your course.

Your offer material will include details about the scholarship you've been awarded and the terms and conditions for accepting the offer.

When you accept an Equity Scholarship offer, you must agree to provide any personal information requested by ICMS Scholarship Board to assess your ongoing eligibility for the Scholarship.

Your Equity Scholarship offer is made on the condition that you remain eligible to receive the Equity Scholarship on each census date during the currency of your Scholarship.

Deferment:

Deferment of an Equity Scholarship is not permitted prior to your course or during.

Students awarded an Equity Scholarship who defer the start of their studies or who withdraw from their course, will forfeit their Equity Scholarship. Students may re-apply for a scholarship if they start studies at ICMS at a later date.

Termination of an ICMS Equity Scholarship:

If the Equity Scholarship you've been awarded is for longer than one year, it will be terminated if:

- You cease to meet the eligibility requirements for your Equity Scholarship
- The maximum duration of the Equity Scholarship has been reached (if applicable)
- You've failed to make satisfactory academic progress as defined by ICMS
- You've committed misconduct (e.g. provided false or misleading information – See Student Handbook)

NOTE: *Scholarship submissions will **not be returned**. Unsuccessful applications are not retained and will be securely destroyed.*

Terms & Conditions (please read carefully before signing the declaration)

1. All scholarships awarded are subject to approval and final selection by the final ICMS Scholarships Chair and panel and this decision is final.
2. International College of Management, Sydney (ICMS) Equity Scholarships are not refundable and non-transferrable, meaning the scholarship cannot be converted to another program, education provider, or recipient nominated by the original recipient.
3. Once the successful recipient has been notified of the scholarship value, that value is not negotiable and not changeable.
4. The recipient of the ICMS Equity Scholarship agrees to abide by all admissions criteria and all requirements in the student handbook whilst enrolled. (<https://handbook.icms.edu.au/>)
5. The recipient of the ICMS Equity Scholarship must commence the program in the February 2027 study period.
6. Applicants must have a full time or equivalent study load to be eligible to apply.
7. If the recipient of an ICMS Equity Scholarship fails a subject, the recipient is obliged to retake the subject at their cost at the full subject price; this decision will be at the discretion of the Chair of ICMS Scholarships.
8. The ICMS Equity Scholarship is a tuition waiver (and/or accommodation) waiver that can only be used for the purpose of attending ICMS for the program as specified. The balance of remaining fees, including tuition, accommodation, uniforms, text books and any other program related costs for each enrolling study period must be paid in full prior to study period commencement.
9. The scholarship amount awarded will be credited to tuition as a portion of the fees in each study period for the duration of the course of their study or until the scholarship credit is exhausted. Scholarship credit can and may be applied to a later study period than the commencement study period.
10. In the case of the scholarship recipient discontinuing studies any and all remaining credit will be forfeited.
11. The value of the scholarship and the timing of the credit apportionment are not negotiable and not changeable.
12. Previous scholarship recipients cannot have existing scholarship credit remaining as at the commencement of the study period they are applying for*.
13. If the recipient's scholarship involves a work placement and a tuition credit component, the tuition credit will apply to the next term of study.
14. At no time will any scholarship credit apply to fees already paid.
15. Partial scholarships are likely to be awarded when application numbers are high.
16. The ICMS Equity Scholarship is not available to students using any other scholarship, bursary or discount at ICMS**.
17. The recipient acknowledges and upholds the confidentiality of receiving the ICMS Equity Scholarship.
18. With respect to the sometimes sensitive nature of the ICMS Equity Scholarship, this scholarship will not be announced at any event or ceremony.
19. The ICMS Equity Scholarship offers a tuition waiver and/or accommodation/living costs credit.

Accommodation/Living Costs Credit description:

Rooms are equipped with a desk, wardrobe, heating and wireless internet. All linen is provided and rooms are dusted and vacuumed once a week. Each floor is equipped with a kitchenette, common showers, toilets and ironing facilities. You will also receive residential support from the residential assistants.

Your accommodation/Living Costs credit includes the following for the duration of the scholarship credit and eligibility:

- Rent
- 3 x Meals per day (Breakfast, Lunch and Dinner) – Monday to Friday

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- 2 x Meals per day (Brunch and Dinner) - Weekends
 - Electricity, Gas & Water
 - On site parking
 - Campus wide Wi-Fi
20. ICMS provides support and assistance, through the Student Success Center here at the college. It is expected that the student where required or needed will be proactive in seeking these services as required in order to complete their studies to the best of their ability.
 21. The ICMS Equity Scholarship recipients must be 18 years of age within six months of commencing the ICMS Bachelor Degree.
 22. ICMS Equity Scholarships may be discontinued by the College, dependent upon termly review of academic integrity, standing and student conduct.
 23. Academic Integrity: Academic misconduct will be reviewed from time to time. Any academic misconduct can inhibit your scholarship. Should your academic misconduct be registered as level 2 or 3 during your applicable scholarship, the scholarship credit will be immediately discontinued.
 24. The ICMS Equity Scholarship is not able to be deferred.
 25. College fees are subject to change.

*Exemptions may apply depending on the scholarship type.

**Excludes the ICMS Regional and Interstate Student Accommodation Bursary.
